- I certify that I will enroll for courses abroad that will be accepted as academic credit earned towards my graduation from UIC. Credit earned must be at least a letter grade of D.
- I certify that I am degree seeking and have not already fulfilled my graduation requirements.
- I will notify my sponsored study abroad office at UIC and the Office of Student Financial Aid at UIC promptly if I withdraw from my course(s), reduce my enrollment or change my courses. I understand that such actions will affect my financial aid eligibility resulting in my student account at UIC being billed for the aid which I am no longer eligible to receive. This can occur even after I have returned from abroad or graduated depending on the time it takes for my transcripts to be received.
- I understand that I am responsible for submitting an official academic transcript to the UIC Study Abroad Office or the Office of International Affairs at UIC immediately after my semester abroad.
- Confirm with your UIC Program Coordinator/ Advisor that there is an agreement between UIC and the Institution where they facilitate the Study Abroad Program.
- To be eligible for federal student loans, students must be enrolled and earn at least 6 hours (5 hours for the Graduate College and School of Public Health).
- I understand that Financial Aid is disbursed to the UIC Student Account (if eligible). I am directly responsible for paying the Abroad Program/Institution once I receive my refund.
- I understand that I must meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) to be eligible for financial aid. Detailed SAP Policy is available at: http://www.uic.edu/depts/financialaid/sap_policy.shtml

PLEASE NOTE: Approval of this agreement is not automatic or guaranteed. Alternative Loans (which are subject to credit check approval) may be the only financial aid options available.
