Submit all documents prior to **July 1, 2017**, to OSFA to the address above or Upload through the UIC Student Portal → Finances → Student Self-Service Login for Financial Aid → Requirements.

- (1) The completed Verification Worksheet
- (2) Your and your parent(s)' tax information

Additional Notes:

- If you and/or your parent(s) filed an amended tax return, submit a signed copy of the 1040X, the original tax return transcript, and copies of the W-2 form(s)
- If a tax return from a foreign country was filed, submit a copy of the tax return and wage statements filed, and a statement with the figures converted to U.S. dollars.
- ***Failure to submit all the documents prior to July 1, 2017, will result in you not being eligible for the Health Professions Loan for the 2017/2018 academic year.***
